STATUS REPORT: LIVING HANDS UMBRELLA TRUST

1. We would like to report as follows:

Discovery is a pre-trial procedure in a lawsuit whereby each party, through the law of civil procedure, can obtain evidence from the other party or parties by means of discovery devices such as a request for answers to interrogatories, request for production of documents, request for admissions and depositions. Discovery can be obtained from non-parties using subpoenas. When a discovery request is objected to, the requesting party may seek the assistance of the court by filing a motion to compel discovery.

- 2. The legal team has requested meetings with various material witnesses.
- 3. The legal team is also in the process of preparing a request for further particulars for trial.
- 4. No pre-trial conference date has been set. A Pre-trial conference of the parties only will be arranged once requests for admissions and trial particulars have been delivered.
- 5. A date for trial can only be obtained after the preceding legal processes have been completed.
